Western Fair Association General Manager & CEO Receives Prestigious Award

Western Fair Association General Manager and CEO, Gary McRae, was awarded the Canadian Association of Fairs & Exhibitions' highest honour. The prestigious Roll of Honour was presented to him at the CAFE convention in Toronto on November 17th. This award recognizes Gary for his leadership, vision, expertise and significant contributions to the fair industry locally, nationally and internationally.

McRae received his Certified Fair Executive (CFE) designation from the International Association of Fairs & Exhibitions (IAFE) in 1993. He is past chair of IAFE as well as past president of Racetracks of Canada.

A 32-year employee of Western Fair, McRae was promoted to General Manager in 1991. Over the past ten years, he has overseen \$66 million in upgrades and expansion, including an expanded slots lounge, a new 165,000 sq. ft. Agriplex, race paddock and a 4-pad arena facility.

McRae becomes the third honoree from Western Fair to receive the highly respected CAFE Roll of Honour award, joining Anne Eadie and former General Manager, Evan McGugan.
