A Few Things to Remember

- Please read the General Rules and Information on pages 4-8.
- Only works of art completed in the last three years that are finished and framed will be accepted.
- A 10cm x 15cm (4" x 6") photograph or photographic transparency (slide) in a 5cm x 5cm (2" x 2") cardboard or thin plastic mount of each piece of artwork entered must be submitted with an official entry form.
- Please be sure that each photo or transparency of artwork is clearly labelled on the back with section, title of work and name of exhibitor.
- Entry tags will not be mailed. Entry tags will be presented upon arrival to the Fair.
- We suggest exhibitors entering an article of value, arrange for their own insurance coverage, if desired.

A Few Things to Remember

- If you compete in Class 63B you cannot compete in any other Fine Art class.
- If you have never entered one of our art competitions before, enter this Class in your first year.
- If you have entered this Class before but not won a prize you may enter again if you feel more comfortable in a novice category. However once you have won a prize in Class 63B you cannot enter again, you move on to Class 63 for any future competitions as you are no longer a novice fine art exhibitor.
