A Few Things to Remember

- Please read General Rules and Information on pages 4-8.
- Entries received by August 15th regardless of the number of classes entered will receive one parking pass and one admission to the Fair for September 13, 2008. These will be mailed to the contestant.
- All entries must be made on the printed entry form found at the end of this book. If entries in any section are not sufficient to ensure competition, the committee reserves the right to cancel any section or incorporate it with another suitable section.
- A contestant may enter both fiddling and step dancing competitions, but may enter in one section only in each class with the exception of Group Step Dancing and Duet Fiddling
- When age is a condition of entry it will be calculated as of January 1, 2007.
- The above judging schedule is tentative and subject to change depending on entries received.

A Few Things to Remember

- Please read General Rules and Information on page 6.
- Scoring will be based on the following criteria: Timing, Precision of Footwork, Quality & Variety of Steps, Showmanship & Personality
- The Western Fair Association will provide an experienced violin/piano duo or you may use your own violin/piano duo. All contestants must dance to live music. A panel of three experienced judges will be provided. In all cases, the judges' decision is final.

GROUP ENTRIES

- To determine in which age category a group must compete, divide the total ages by the number of dancers in the group. (Average ages of 11.2 or 11.9 for example are considered 11 years of age and under.) Any prize money that may be awarded to a group will be paid to the person who makes the entry.
- Entry form must be received in office with individual information for prize cheque allocation in upper portion. That person becomes responsible for dividing up prize monies to remaining group members. In case of Jr. Group entries the cheque payable to section must be filled in by parent/guardian if child does not have bank account.
- Bottom portion of entry form should include Group name, Entrant's name, Cities travelling from (for MC) as well as the name of the tune being performed (fiddling competition).
