Ken Taylor Passes

LONDON, Ontario (January 21, 2010) . . . Ken Taylor, husband of Joyce Taylor, who has worked at Western Fair Raceway for many years in the race office and as the Standardbred Canada field representative, passed away this past Tuesday. He was 74. Ken served as the paddock judge at Clinton Raceway for more than 20 years until 1996. A resident of Clinton, Ontario, he died at the Stratford General Hospital.
