Molson Night At Western Fair

Western Fair Raceway will offer the richest card of racing in its 49 year history tonight anchored by the 38th edition of their signature race, the Molson Pace which goes for a record purse of \$312,000.

In addition to the Molson Pace, the card includes an \$130,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Gold final for three-year-old pacing fillies in race five and four finals of the City of London Series worth approximately \$50,000 each. They are carded as races three, four, six and nine.

The program also features a \$20,000 Invitation Pace as race eight which includes two starters in last Friday night's Molson Pace eliminations, Wholly Louy (post four) and Blueridge Western (post six). Silent Swing, a finalist in last year's Molson Pace, starts from post three in that race with top driver Dave Miller down to drive.

Please note that tonight's card is the final live race card at Western Fair for the next few months. Racing will return for three days, September 13,14 and 15 during the annual Western Fair with the fall/winter meet then starting on October 15.
